The Regular meeting of the Supervisors of Schuylkill Township was held on Monday, December 3rd, 2018 in the Municipal Building. Those present included Charles Hosler and Frank Fabrizio. The Pledge of the Allegiance was recited. Charles Hosler made a motion to approve the November's Regular Meeting Minutes. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved.

Treasurer's Report

\$350,381.75 total in bank accounts. Hosler made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report pending audit. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved.

Answers to Last Month's Public Questions- None

Public comment on agenda items only – Joe Yesavage, Tuscarora, asked if the township did anything for his drainage issues. Hosler and Yesavage discussed time frames regarding addressing the issue. Mark Buccieri (from maintenance) stated that he did dig it out and tried to zig zag it as to slow down the water flow. Yesavage also stated that the ditch on the right hand side of Union Street is getting eroded.

Police Report – None

Code Enforcement Report – None

Road master Report- Hosler stated that the water drain complaints were worked on and filled potholes. Numerous repairs were made on the trucks to get ready for the snow season. GMC died after an hour in the last snow storm and it was taken to Penske. Hosler made a motion to get two loads of salt. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved.

Solicitors Report-Baranko brought up the Resolution 2016-2 Zoning Board Application Fees with regards to the newspaper's fees increasing for advertising and rising stenographic fees; an issue that was tabled last meeting with Atty. Lucas. Hosler wanted to table issue until all three supervisors were present.

Zoning Report- No permits were issued.

Committee Report-Council of Government-met with the representative from Mascaro regarding an electronics recycling event in Spring; Tax Collection Committee – meets next month; Eastern Schuylkill Recreation Committee – did not meet.

Communications: Correspondence from William Brior thanking the board and asking for consideration for re-appointment as Primary Sewage Enforcement Officer in 2019 and appointing Samantha Brior as Alternate Sewage Enforcement Officer in 2019. Correspondence from Schuylkill Headwaters thanking Schuylkill Township for the contribution of \$100.00.

Old Business- None

New Business- Hosler made a motion to approve the 2019 Annual Budget with the total revenues are \$ 459,189 and the total expenditures are \$455,440 and no tax increase this is Resolution 2018-7. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved. Hosler made a motion to approve 2019 meeting dates including the Planning Commission and the Auditors meeting. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved. Hosler stated the Planning Commission approved the subdivision contingent upon the items on the list that were to be addressed by Jack Slane. Hosler made a motion to approve the Snukis variance contingent upon the items that were to be addressed by the surveyor Jack

Slane. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved. The Coal Street Pub owner presented Schuylkill Township with a check for \$900.00 from a fundraiser for a taser. Fabrizio made a motion to renew the township's website for \$300.00 (annual fee). 2nd Hosler. All approved.

Public Comment

Joe Yesavage, Tuscarora, asked about the township backhoe coming up to rearrange the ditch to avoid water going into his garage. Yesavage and Hosler discussed water issues and the issue of the township backhoe going onto private property. Ronald Coleman, spoke about discussions with previous supervisors and their lack of doing anything regarding the water. There was also discussion about the culvert by Coal Street. It was discussed that what Buccieri did do could have slowed the water flow down and Coleman stated it doesn't help with the volume.

Hosler made a motion to adjourn the meeting. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved.
