The Regular meeting of the Supervisors of Schuylkill Township was held on Monday, June 4th, 2018 in the Municipal Building. Those present included Charles Fayash, Charles Hosler, and Frank Fabrizio. The Pledge of the Allegiance was recited.

Charles Hosler made a motion to approve the May's Regular Meeting Minutes. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved.

Treasurer's Report

\$389,226.75 total in bank accounts. Charles Fayash made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report pending audit. 2nd Hosler. All approved.

Answers to Last Month's Public Questions- None

Public comment on agenda items only – None

Police Report – 22 total calls for May. Fayash stated some of the calls included harassment citations, traffic citations, littering. Also lines were painted on roads. Fayash stated the 25 mile per hour signs are back up in Newkirk.

Code Enforcement Report – Property on Piersol Street has been condemned and owner notified by letter. Buchinsky is cleaning up his property and has been moving junk and vehicles. Swenson has removed all his junk from the street and will continue to do so.

Road master Report- Hosler stated that the gutters and culverts were cleaned out, filled potholes, worked on police jeep, and put up the flags. One hundred flags had been donated by Remember When Video. Fayash suggested that the township fill the holes on Route 209 with the detour starting. Fayash made a motion to get more material (5 tons coal patch) for filling potholes. 2nd Hosler. All approved.

Solicitors Report-Slusser stated Dave Horst's opinion regarding the Tarcon Land in Tuscarora (17 acres) that a subdivision is not required based on the fact that it is separately assessed. A resolution by the board has to be signed but it does have to go before the planning commission. Baranko had the board conditionally approve the resolution 2018-6 subject to planning commission review. This was added to New Business. Baranko also discussed the Ordinance 2-2018 wording, vacancy addition, and amendment to garbage ordinance for advertisement.

Zoning Report- None

Committee Report-

Council of Government- Hosler stated COG met and reviewed guidelines for equipment, assessed costs, checklist to sign off on. Tax Collection Committee – no quorum. Eastern Schuylkill Recreation Committee – Fabrizio stated a new director had been hired.

Communications: The township received a thank you letter from the Schuylkill County Veterans Trip Organization. The township received notification that it will receive \$607.50 in State Police Fines & Penalties

Old Business- The generators bid to be placed on website hopefully this month. Need checks for the Garbage Fund and Liquid Fuels Fund. Riverview quoted \$117.99 plus shipping of \$23.85 for a total of \$141.84 for 250 checks and \$176.25 for 500 checks and \$337.40 for 1000 checks. Government Forms & Supplies quoted \$135 + shipping for 500 checks and \$195 + shipping for 1000 checks. Fayash made a motion to purchase 1000

checks at \$195+shipping for each account (Garbage & Liquid Fuels) through Government Forms & Supplies. 2nd Hosler. All approved.

New Business-

Hosler made a motion to advertise in the Republican the Community Yard Sale on June 23rd. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved. Times News did not respond back yet with pricing. The public is welcome to put up his/her own signs. Fayash made a motion to pass Resolution 2018-6 which waives subdivision submission for Tarcon conditioned upon the Planning Commission Review. 2nd Hosler. All approved. Fayash made a motion to advertise Ordinance 2-2018 amendment to Garbage Ordinance. 2nd Hosler. All approved. Hosler made a motion to pay the Schuylkill Chamber of Commerce annual dues of \$325.00. 2nd Fayash. All approved.

Public Comment

Rich Magnani, Brockton, expressed concerns about people parking along Valley Street where it is posted no parking here to corner; for people coming off Mine Street. Magnani expressed concerns with a trailer park forming at the turn to Firehouse Road with people living in them. Fayash stated as long as they are registered there isn't anything the township can do. Magnani questioned the right away off the road in relation to someone's property. Fayash stated Dimarco could probably answer questions about this.

Leona Kurchak, Mary D, questioned about filling a large swimming pool and permits required, along with cars. Fayash stated Dimarco would look in to the property at 44 Dodson Street (Marsteller). There were complaints about Buchinsky's cars and trash on his property.

Fayash made a motion to enter executive session.

After executive session Hosler made a motion to appoint Light Heigel for Zoning Officer duties at \$65/hr. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved.

Fayash made a motion to adjourn the meeting. 2nd Hosler. All approved.
