The Regular meeting of the Supervisors of Schuylkill Township was held on Monday, June 1st, 2020. The Pledge of the Allegiance was recited. Those present included Charles Fayash, Charles Hosler, and Frank Fabrizio.

Charles Hosler made a motion to approve the May Meeting Minutes. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved.

Treasurer's Report

\$470,325.60 total in bank accounts. Charles Fayash made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report pending audit. 2nd Hosler. All approved.

Visa credit card report – no current balance.

Public comment on agenda items only - none

Police Report – 29 calls from March 1 – June 1, 2020. DiMarco stated traffic arrest (pursuit), trespassing, abandoned vehicle, reports of drug deals at the Mary D Ballfield, littering, assist other agency, were among the calls. DiMarco stated the township was approved for \$28,500 for a grant from the JE Morgan Foundation for LPR reader and computer for inside the car. DiMarco thanked the JE Morgan Foundation for their generosity. DiMarco stated that there is a warrant for arrest for felony fleeing (pertaining to the chase in Tuscarora). DiMarco stated that Officer Stanell suggested sending certified letters to the major offenders (of the QOL) first. Some people responded and some did not. Then he went about tagging doors with tickets. DiMarco discussed the process. Oldt stated QOL have thirty days to pay fine. DiMarco is to give a report on the QOL every month to the supervisors. DiMarco discussed the notice of violation for the Farber property. DiMarco can now go forward with the arrest. DiMarco stated there are animal cruelty and two drug cases pending at this time. Hosler asked Baranko what the next step is in the Farber case. Baranko stated he has thirty days to remediate (based on the notice of violation letter). DiMarco stated he was going ahead with the public nuisance arrest now (criminal level). Baranko stated it is on two different levels. DiMarco stated he will hand deliver the letter to Mr. Farber as well. Fayash thanked Chief DiMarco for getting the JE Morgan grant.

Code Enforcement Report – included in the police report.

Roadmaster Report- Hosler reported cut township grass, potholes were patched, cleaned drains, picked up trash and tires, maintenance of equipment and vehicles. Discussion ensued about littering. Hosler stated one of the pavers came out to take information on a quote and he is waiting to hear back from another one. Fayash asked about getting hot patch and discussed working with another township on using their roller.

Solicitors Report- Atty. Baranko discussed adding the increase of the fees for SALDO in the resolution that would be adding a refundable fee for recording subdivisions. Fayash made a motion to table this until next meeting. 2nd Hosler. All approved. Discussion the not for profit and the amusement tax assessment ensued. Hosler made a motion to extend the emergency declaration with Resolution 2020-3 until the next meeting June 1st. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved.

Zoning Report- No zoning permits were issued in May. One UCC building permit was issued in May (Zelonis pool). Two driveway permits were issued in May (Williams).

Old Business - Fayash made a motion to table the Resolution regarding SALDO increase in fees and deposit requirement until next meeting. 2nd Hosler. All approved. Fayash made a motion to approve Resolution 2020-4 for the JE Morgan Grant for \$28,500. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved. Fayash made a motion to appoint Colleen Barrett as the lead for the JE Morgan Grant using the General Fund. 2nd Hosler. All approved.

New Business- Fayash made a motion to approve Resolution 2020-5 (expires July 6, 2020) Declaration on Disaster Emergency extension form Resolution 2020 -3. 2nd Hosler. All approved. Discussion regarding the bid and garbage contract.

Public Comment – Rich Magnani, Brockton, questioned the non-permit for 325-327 Valley Street. Magnani was told it was going through the Zoning Officer.

Gary Feathers, Tuscarora, the Tuscarora Fire Company has decided to cancel it's Annual Block Party. Feathers asked the township for permission to close down Mulberry Street from the corner to Post office from 10 am – 2pm on June 13th for their hoagie sale/pickup. Fayash made a motion to approve the closure of Mulberry Street from the corner to the Post office from 10am-2pm on June 13th. 2nd Hosler. All approved. Feathers asked the police to please patrol Tuscarora by the grove for ATV running through the grove especially on the weekends.

Fayash made a motion to go into executive session. 2nd Fabrizio.

Fayash stated the Board discussed ordinance violations and Zoning.

Fayash made a motion to adjourn the meeting. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved.
