ORDINANCE NO. 6-73

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND RESTRICTING  
OUTDOOR FIRES WITHIN SCHUYLKILL TOWNSHIP  
AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION  
THEREOF.

The Township of Schuylkill hereby ordains as follows:

1. No person or persons shall set or maintain any fire upon any of the streets, sidewalks, alleys or public grounds in Schuylkill Township, or burn or cause to be burned thereon any paper, boxes, rubbish, leaves or other materials or substance of any kind. Nor shall any person or persons set or maintain any fire or burn or cause to be burned any substance or material of any kind out of doors anywhere within any of the villages of said Township or within 100 feet of any of the buildings in said villages.

2. Out of door fires shall be permitted upon private property in those parts of the Township outside of the villages in the Township, provided that the following regulations or restrictions are strictly adhered to; every such outdoor fire shall be built in and confined to a non-cumbustible container covered with a screen of  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch or smaller mesh or with other suitable non-cumbustible container. No such fire shall be closer than 25 feet from any building or from any property line. No such fire shall be allowed to burn upon any day except between the hours of 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM.

3. Any person who shall violate or fail to conform to any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon

conviction thereof be sentenced to pay a fine no less than \$20.00 and costs of prosecution and in default of such fine and costs, imprisonment for not more than 10 days.

All ordinances and part of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
