

ORDINANCE NO. 88-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 75-1 ENACTED APRIL 7, 1975 AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 75-3 ENACTED SEPTEMBER 2, 1975 OF SCHUYLKILL TOWNSHIP, SCHUYLKILL COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA REQUIRING A PERMIT TO BE OBTAINED BEFORE ERECTING, ALTERING OR RAZING ANY BUILDING IN SCHUYLKILL TOWNSHIP, REQUIRING SUBMISSION OF PLANS, PROVIDING FEES THEREFOR, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES

SECTION 1

Section 2 of Ordinance NO. 75-1, enacted April 7, 1975, as amended by Ordinance NO. 75-3 enacted September 2, 1975, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2: No person shall cause or permit any building to be erected, razed or any alteration to be made therein, upon any property owned by such person, or upon any ground rented by him, in the case of a ground rental arrangement, without first having obtained a permit therefor. Such permit shall be issued by the township official designated by the Township Supervisors, upon the filing of an application with him, submission of plans and specifications in the case of erection or alteration of any building, and furnishing evidence of intended compliance with the requirements of all applicable laws, statutes, and regulations including but not limited to the Township of Schuylkill regulating building construction as required by the application form. In the case of erection or

alteration of any building, the fee for the permit shall be as follows:

(a) Ten (\$10.00) Dollars for the first Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars of construction;

(b) Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars for the next Forty Thousand (\$40,000.00) Dollars of construction;


(c) Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars for any construction in excess of the Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars of construction referred to in subparagraphs (a) and (b).


In the case of the razing of a building, the fee for the permit shall be Two (\$2.00) Dollars.
