

**SCHUYLKILL TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE NO. 91-6**

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE GRANTING OF
HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES AT THE REQUEST
OF ANY HANDICAPPED PERSON WHO IS A RESIDENT
OF SCHUYLKILL TOWNSHIP.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors
of Schuylkill Township, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by
the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. At the request of any handicapped person,
the Board of Supervisors, by motion, may authorize the erection
on a Township Street, as close as possible to their place of
residence, a sign or signs indicating that that place is reserved
for a handicapped person, and that no parking is allowed there by
other than a handicapped person. At the discretion of the Board
of Supervisors, it may, by motion, remove any signs erected
pursuant to this section at any time.

Section 2. The Board of Supervisors may, at its
discretion, set up guidelines, which at its discretion, may be
changed, or deviated from at anytime to regulate the granting of
parking spaces for handicapped persons as set forth in Section 1.

Section 3. Any unauthorized person parking in spaces
established pursuant to Section 1, shall be guilty of a summary
offense and pay a fine of Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars.

Section 4. Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance
conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and
the same is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage, and approved in the manner prescribed by law.
