# ORDINANCE NO. 8-2011

# AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS OF SCHUYLKILL TOWNSHIP, SCHUYLKILL COUNTY, AUTHORIZING WITHDRAW FROM THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM,

WHEREAS, Schuylkill Township (the Township), Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, elected to join the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System (PMRS) effective January 1, 1990, in order to provide a Police Pension Plan by adoption of Ordinance No. 89-3; and

WHEREAS, the Township finds it to be in the best interest of the Township to withdraw this Plan from the PMRS because it no longer has any employees and the last retiree is now deceased with no benefits payable to the beneficiary.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT:

- 1. The Township hereby elects to withdraw the Police Pension Plan from the PMRS, effective August 3, 2011.
- 2. All assets and liabilities in the municipal account presently maintained by PMRS shall be returned to the township as soon as practical.
- 3. The Township hereby certifies that there are no active, vested, nor retired members of the Plan and therefore, no affirmative vote to withdraw the Plan has been obtained from at least 75% of all active, vested, and retired members of the Plan.
- 4. The Township assumes all liability for all active, vested, and retired members (of which there are not), effective August 3, 2011.
- All Ordinances and Resolution inconsistent with the action are hereby repealed as is specifically Ordinance No. 89-3. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.

### ORDINANCE NO. 8-20//

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS OF SCHUYLKILL TOWNSHIP, SCHUYLKILL COUNTY, AUTHORIZING WITHDRAW FROM THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM,

- 5. All Ordinances and Resolution inconsistent with the action are hereby repealed as is specifically Ordinance No. 89-3. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
