A RESOLUTION
REJECTING THE LEASE PROPOSAL OF GUARANTY TOWERS

Whereas, Schuylkill Township has been approached regarding the lease of Township property to Guaranty Towers for the purpose of constructing a multi-user telecommunications tower.

Whereas, a public meeting to discuss the proposal was held on February 24, 2000.

Whereas, the Township does not intend to prohibit or have the effect of prohibiting the ability of any entity to provide any interstate or intrastate telecommunications service.

Whereas, the citizens at that meeting were not in favor of the proposal.


Whereas, the Township owns no land zoned for construction of a telecommunications tower.

Be it resolved, by the Supervisors of the Township of Schuylkill not to lease Township property for such purposes.

Furthermore, be it resolved that the Township is not in favor of the construction of a telecommunications tower in the Township in any location, which would have a detrimental effect on the health, safety or welfare of its citizens.


