RESOLUTION OF THE SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SCHUYLKILL APPROVING THE FISCAL YEAR 2005 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ENTITLEMENT PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING ITS SUBMISSION TO THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, pursuant to Act No. 179 of 1984, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania will distribute Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) funds to entitlement communities and award discretionary funds to non-entitlement communities hereinafter known as Pennsylvania's Small Communities Program (SCP); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Hearings held in connection with the proposed Fiscal Year 2005 Discretionary Program, the Township Supervisors of the Township of Schuylkill has caused to be prepared an application dated March, 2005 for funding in the total amount of \$350,000 under the Community Development Block Grant Discretionary Program; and

WHEREAS, said application includes a Community Development Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Schuylkill has met the citizen participation requirements related to the Small Communities Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SCHUYLKILL:

1. That the Community Development Block Grant Discretionary Application dated March, 2005, is hereby in all respects approved. The Township Secretary is hereby directed to file a copy of said program and application with the minutes of this meeting.
2. That it is cognizant of the conditions that are imposed in the undertaking and carrying out of activities with Community Development Block Grant Program financial assistance, including those relating to the prohibition of discrimination because of race, color, creed or national origin and other assurances as set forth by HUD and/or DCED.
3. That the Chairman of the Township Supervisors, on behalf of the entire Board of Township Supervisors, is authorized to execute such application for financial assistance to carry out the Community Development Block Grant Program and act as the authorized representative of the Township of Schuylkill.
4. That the Chairman of the Supervisors, on behalf of the entire Board of Township Supervisors, is hereby authorized to provide such assurances and/or certifications as required by the Community Development Block Grant Program, and any supplemental or revised data which DCED may request in connection with its review of the Application.
