2011 Municipal/County Emergency Operations Plan Update

March 17, 2011

Dear Municipal Official,

As you know every municipality in Schuylkill County is required to have an Emergency Operations Plan for their community. The last major changes to the basic municipal plan were completed in 2003. As part of the on-going process to ensure our preparedness for all hazards, Schuylkill County Emergency Management Agency has completed the update of the Basic Plan for all municipalities in the County. We will also be utilizing this same document as the County Basic Plan to satisfy the principles of uniform incident management and to lessen the burden of updating for our municipalities.

The Schuylkill County Board of Commissioners officially approved the Emergency Operations Plan on March 9, 2011. Now is the time for local elected officials to approve the Basic Plan on behalf of their municipality.

The purpose of this plan is to prescribe those activities to be taken by the county/municipal government and other community officials to protect the lives and property of the citizens in the event of a natural or human-caused emergency or disaster, including terrorism, and to satisfy the requirements of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, (35 Pa. C.S. Section 7101 et seq., as amended), to have a disaster emergency management plan for the county/municipality.

The plan consists of: a Basic Plan, which describes principles and doctrine; a Notification and Resource Manual, which provides listings and means of contacting local and needed resources; and a series of functional checklists which provide detail for the accomplishment of the specifics of the operation.

The scope of the plan includes all activities in the entire emergency management cycle, including prevention, preparedness, response and recovery phases. This plan is applicable to all response organizations acting for or on behalf of the government or citizens of municipalities in Schuylkill County. Incident specific Plans may augment this plan if necessary to more efficiently cope with special requirements presented by specific hazards.

Each municipality has been provided with a copy of the Basic Plan, as municipalities approve the plan, updates will be completed. We have also completed updates to the Notification and Resource Manual, and Functional Checklists. These documents will be forwarded to your local municipal emergency management coordinator to complete specific municipality information.

Please complete the attached Promulgation Statement to officially approve the Basic Plan for your municipality at your next meeting and return to our office by May 1st, 2011.
