

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Township of Schuylkill has in place a Township police department, and;

WHEREAS, the standard operating procedure is necessary in order to clarify and set forth a guide for police officers in performing their duties, and;

WHEREAS, no specific or general rules can be established which will embrace all cases arising out of the general discharge of a police officer's duty, and;

WHEREAS, the standard operating procedures setting forth rules and regulations as a guide for the performance of the duties of the Township of Schuylkill Police Department, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the supervisors of Schuylkill Township that the police standard operating procedure dated April 6, 2011 is compiled, adopted and published for the guidance and government of the Schuylkill Township Police Department and that the Township reserves the right to amend or revoke any of the rules and regulations or to make additional rules from time to time as circumstances or the good of the department may require. Any violations of the provisions of this standard operating procedure shall be made subject of written disciplinary charges against any member or employee responsible for such violation. Any rules and regulations in order to set forth in the standard operating procedure shall not in any way conflict or supercede the pertinent sections of the Pennsylvania Township Code, as amended which deal with the function and control of the police department.
