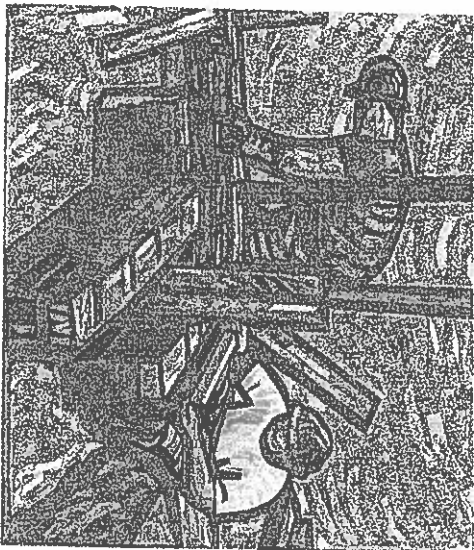

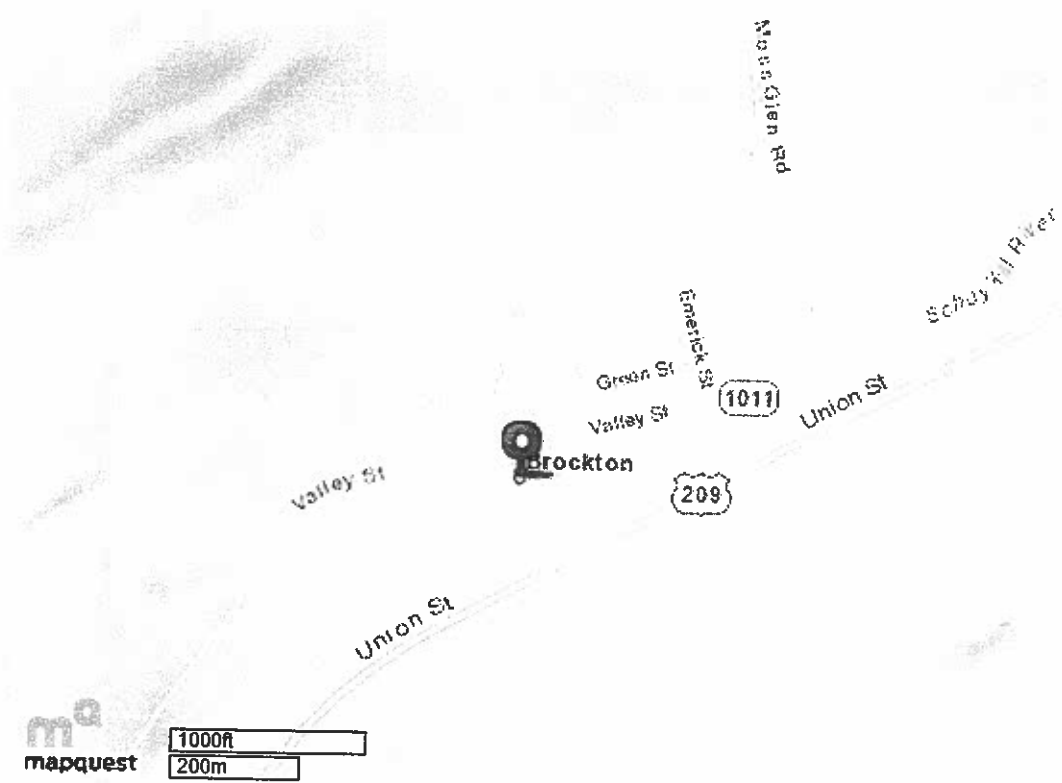

Existing sidewalks on east and west side of building to be removed and repoured. Approximately 577 sq. ft. total for both walks. Front entry steps to also be torn out and repoured. All walks and steps to be reinforced with wire mesh. Concrete to be 3500 P.S.I. Surface to be a magged or broomed finish. Walks to be separated into sections using metal joints or sawcuts as needed. Small retaining wall (about 60 block or less) to be built at end of east walk and running down side for about 16'. WE PROPOSE HEREBY TO FURNISH MATERIAL AND LABOR COMPLETE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ABOVE SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE SUM OF: \$ 381

PAYMENT IS TO BE AS FOLLOWS: 50% deposit due when job is started. Balance due upon completion.

ALL MATERIAL IS GUARANTEED TO BE AS SPECIFIED. ALL WORK TO BE COMPLETED IN A WORKMANLIKE MANNER ACCORDING TO STANDARD PRACTICES.
