

A RESOLUTION 8-2011

WHEREAS, under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development is authorized to extend financial assistance to communities for activities which will benefit low and moderate income families, aid in the elimination or prevention of slums or blight or other urgent community development needs; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Act 179 of 1984, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania will distribute Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to entitlement communities and award discretionary funds to non-entitlement communities, hereinafter known as the Pennsylvania Small Communities Program (SCP); and

WHEREAS, Township of Schuylkill desires to submit an application in the estimated amount of \$500,000 for Federal Fiscal Year 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Township has met all the citizen participation requirements relative to the Program submission; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Schuylkill has prepared an Application for financial assistance under the Community Development Program, said application having been duly reviewed and considered by the Schuylkill Township Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Schuylkill Township Board of Supervisors:

1. That the Community Development Program Application dated August, 2011 is hereby in all respects approved. The Township Secretary is hereby directed to file a copy of said program and application with the minutes of this meeting.
2. That it is cognizant of the conditions that are imposed in the undertaking and carrying out of community development activities with Federal/State financial assistance under Title I, including those under Title VI relating to the prohibition of discrimination because of race, color, creed or national origin and other assurances as may be forthcoming from DCED and/or HUD for the implementation of the Program.
3. That the Chairman of the Schuylkill Township Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the Board of Supervisors, is authorized to file an application for financial assistance to carry out the Small Communities Program and act as the authorized representative of the Township.
4. That the Chairman, on behalf of the Schuylkill Township Board of Supervisors, is hereby authorized to provide such assurances and/or certification as may be required by the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, and any supplemental or revised data which DCED may request in connection with its review of the application and including any revisions necessary to bring the application into conformity with DCED's final grant for the Township.
