Resolution #5-75

WHEREAS, owners of real estate in Schuylkill Township desiring to develop the same by laying out building plots and/or building homes, have proceeded on the expectation that the streets and ways in such development would be constructed by the Township at the expense of the Township; and

WHEREAS the cost of construction of roads and streets in conformity with standards set by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation are of such high expense as to be burdensome on the tax payers of the Township;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that it is the sense and feeling of the Board of Supervisors that any developer or real estate within the Township of Schuylkill, in keeping with the common practice in other municipalities, as part of their respective development shall construct at their expense the necessary streets and ways together with appropriate underground pipes for storm and sanitary sewers and for water as indicated;

AND BE IT FURTHER resolved that any road construction undertaken by any developer shall conform to all standards set by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.
