RESOLUTION NO. 97-2

A RESOLUTION
REQUESTING THE BUILDING INSPECTOR TO INSPECT
PARCEL # 27-7-102 ON PORTER STREET, TUSCARORA TO
DETERMINE IF THE PREMESIS IS FIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Schuylkill Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania is authorized to remove dangerous structures pursuant to Section 1533 of the Second Class Township Code; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinances of Schuylkill Township including but not limited to Ordinance Nos. 301-305 provided procedures for the removal of dangerous structures; and

WHEREAS, the first step in such procedures is for the Board of Supervisors to request the Building Inspector to inspect such dangerous structure to determine if it is fit for human habitation; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board of Supervisors that Parcel # 27-7-102 on Porter Street, Tuscarora, Schuylkill Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, is in a state of disrepair which poses a danger to the health and welfare of the general public;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 1st th of October, 1997 by the Schuylkill Township Board of Supervisors that the Building Inspector is hereby formally requested to inspect Parcel # 27-7-102 on Porter Street, Tuscarora, Schuylkill Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, and is to follow the procedures listed in Schuylkill Township Ordinance Nos. 301-305, in order to determine if the premises are fit for human habitation. If said premises are found to be unfit for human habitation, the Building Inspector shall follow through with proceedings to remove the structure.
