Village of Mary-D commencing at the intersection of T-505 and north on Main Street 750' , then westerly to School Street 600' .

What specific problems would be solved if this project is funded?

The water and service lines replacement will eliminate unpredictable iron particles from being drawn into dwellings and increase flow rates bringing fresh water into the neighborhood. The waterline extension and loop will provide for water circulation and adequate service to a replacement fire hydrant and extend fire service via a new fire hydrant. The project will bring this northerly portion of the water system into compliance with practices, standards and recommendations of the following agencies:

- Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PaDEP)
- Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC)
- American Water Works Association (AWWA)
- National Fire Protection Association (NFPA)
- Insurance Services Office (ISO)

What is the status of the project? (i.e., right-of-way to be acquired, permits needed, engineering and design work to be done).

Engineering design and construction documents are 95% complete. No right-of-way or permits are required.

This project is expected to serve 49 households.

AGREEMENT

This Agreement made this 7th day of October, 19 98, by the Supervisors of Schuylkill Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, hereinafter referred to as 'Township' and the Mary-D Community Association, a non-profit civic association, Village of Mary-D, Schuylkill Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, hereinafter referred to as 'Association'.

WHEREAS, County Commissioners of Schuylkill County have agreed to fund improvements to the northern section in the vicinity of North Main and School Streets in the Village of Mary-D, Schuylkill Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, through a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) involving the installation of waterlines to said residential area; and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Schuylkill County will approve said Grant only if it is administered through the governing body of the Municipality in which the improvements are to be made; and

WHEREAS, the Mary-D Community Association has been involved in improving the drinking water distribution facilities and increasing fire protection in the Village of Mary-D located in Schuylkill Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it agreed by the parties hereto for and in consideration of mutual promises herein contained as follows:

3. Township agrees to issue all checks for payment of bills associated with the aforesaid project out of the CDBG funds to the extent of said Grant funds.

4. The Association agrees to pay the costs of any portion of the project not covered by the aforesaid CDBG. This includes engineering fees, survey work and any other project work not eligible under the terms of the CDBG. It is contemplated the engineering firm of **alfred benesch & company**, Pottsville, Pennsylvania will be the Engineer with respect to said project,

5. The undersigned individuals of the Association represent that they have authority to bind the Association to this Agreement.
