RESOLUTION OF THE (TOWNSHIP) OF Schuylkill
APPROVING SUBMISSION OF CDBG FUNDING REQUEST TO THE COUNTY
OF SCHUYLKILL.

The Township of Schuylkill having met this 3rd day of November, 1999,

in public session, has approved a funding request to the County of Schuylkill in
the amount of \$ 83,860.00 for the project described below:


Replacement of the inadequate and rust encrusted three-inch iron pipe on North Main Street and
the extension of the new waterline to School Street with three (3) interconnects looping the system
for fire protection and adequate service pressure, with the installation of two (2) fire hydrants and
twenty-one (21) new copper replacement service lines.

The Municipal Governing Body authorizes alfred benesch & company to submit the application
for funding on its behalf.

AGREEMENT

This Agreement made this 3rd day of November, 1999, by the Supervisors of Schuylkill Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, hereinafter referred to as 'Township' and the Mary-D Community Association, a non-profit civic association, Village of Mary-D, Schuylkill Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, hereinafter referred to as 'Association'.

WHEREAS, County Commissioners of Schuylkill County have agreed to fund improvements to the northern section in the vicinity of North Main and School Streets in the Village of Mary-D, Schuylkill Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, through a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) involving the installation of waterlines to said residential area; and

WHEREAS, THE County Commissioners of Schuylkill County will approve said Grant only if it is administered through the governing body of the Municipality in which the improvements are to be made; and

WHEREAS, THE Mary-D Community Association has been involved in improving the drinking water distribution facilities and increasing fire protection in the Village of Mary-D located in Schuylkill Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania;


NOW, THEREFORE, be agreed by the parties hereto for and in consideration of mutual promises herein contained as follows:

1. The Township agrees to do what is necessary to obtain the 83,860.00 CDBG to be approved by the County Commissioners of Schuylkill County.
2. The Township agrees to apply the proceeds of said Grant to the installation of waterlines, fire hydrants and other improvements to be made to the northern section of the Village of Mary-D, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania and for no other purpose.
3. Township agrees to issue all checks for payment of bills associated with the aforesaid project out of the CDBG funds to the extent of said Grant funds.

4. The Association agrees to pay the costs of any portion of the project not covered by the aforesaid CDBG. This includes engineering fees, survey work and any other project work not eligible under the terms of the CDBG. It is contemplated the engineering firm of **alfred benesch & company**, Pottsville, Pennsylvania will be the Engineer with respect to said project.


5. The undersigned individuals of the Association represent that they have authority to bind the Association to this Agreement.
