

## RESOLUTION 49-8

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SCHUYLKILL, SCHUYLKILL COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA (herein after "the municipality").

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act", as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires the Municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said Plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the Municipality, and

WHEREAS, alfred benesch & company has prepared a Joint Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Update on behalf of the Schuylkill Valley Sewer Authority, of which the Township of Schuylkill is a member, provides for sewage facilities in a portion of the Township of Schuylkill, and

The alternative of choice to be implemented is local collection systems with interceptor to one (1) wastewater treatment plant. The key implementation activities/dates include:

Receive Act 537 Plan Approval	0 days
Commence Design	7 days after Act 537 approval
Submit NPDES Part I Permit	60 days after Commencing Design
Complete Design and Submit Part II Permit and General Permits	390 days after Act 537 approval
Submit PennDOT Highway Occupancy Permit (HOP)	During Final Design of Collection System
Receive PennDOT approval for HOP	Within 30 days after submission
Receive All Permits and Bid Project	540 days after Act 537 approval
Bid Opening	600 days after Act 537 approval
Notice of Award	660 days after Act 537 approval
Loan Closing	645 days after Act 537 approval
Notice to Proceed	674 days after Act 537 approval
Begin Construction	688 days after Act 537 approval
Substantial Completion	1188 days after Act 537 approval
Project On-line	1228 days after Act 537 approval

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the monthly user charge for the chosen alternative will be approximately Thirty-eight (\$38.00) Dollars per month per EDU.

WHEREAS, Township of Schuylkill finds that the Facility Plan described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Schuylkill, hereby adopts and submits to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the "Official Plan" of the Municipality, the above referenced Facility Plan. The Municipality hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said Plan as required by law. (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act as amended.)

AND ALSO, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Schuylkill hereby authorizes Schuylkill Valley Sewer Authority to apply for and receive any grants from all state and federal agencies which may be available for any planning and design assistance related to the above referenced revision.
