The Regular meeting of the Supervisors of Schuylkill Township was held on Monday, March 1st, 2021 in the Municipal Building. The Pledge of the Allegiance was recited. Those present included Charles Fayash, Charles Hosler, and Frank Fabrizio.

Charles Hosler made a motion to approve the February Meeting Minutes. 2nd Fayash. All approved.

Treasurer's Report

\$429,471.43 total in bank accounts. Hosler made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report pending audit. 2nd Fayash. All approved.

Police Report – 12 speeding citations, 2 expired inspections, 1 expired registration, 1 stop sign violation, 1 driving without a license, and 1 driving under suspension, along with 2 disable vehicles, abandoned vehicle, barking dog, unwanted person, and missing person. Police car needs front rotors and brakes (all around) and an oil change, all fluids will be topped off, front end skid plate plastic replacement (for free) quote \$782.00. Quote \$550 (labor included) on the jeep motor from All Indoor came out of Jeep with 88,000 miles on it and it ran before they took the motor out, no warranty with the quote. Hosler made a motion to approve the repairs for the police car at Frank DiMarco's Auto Body at \$782.00. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved. Hosler made a motion to replace the motor for the jeep at Frank DiMarco's Auto Body at \$550.00. 2nd Fayash. All approved.

Code Enforcement Report – None

Roadmaster Report- Buccieri stated the township plowed roads. Hosler made a motion to purchase three loads of salt. 2nd Fayash. All approved. Fayash made a motion to give Mark Buccieri a raise of \$21/hour. Motion died. Discussion ensued. Hosler made a motion to give Mark Buccieri a raise to \$20/hour. 2nd Fayash. All approved. Fayash made a motion to start his raise on 3/7/21. 2nd Hosler. All approved. to purchase a load (5 ton) of coal patch. 2nd Hosler. All approved.

Solicitors Report-Atty. Baranko discussed the LST tax. His recommendation is doing an updated ordinance. Hosler made a motion to have Atty. Baranko work up a new LST ordinance with the rate being \$52.00. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved.

Zoning Report- no permits was issued.

Roy Habel, Tuscarora, asked if the tree limbs could be trimmed around a sign near fire hydrant and litter cleaned up.

Fayash asked about hiring help for Mark Buccieri. Discussion ensued regarding workers comp, temporary employees, subcontractors, and costs. The supervisors asked for a cost estimate from our insurance company.

Hosler made a motion to purchase a load (5 ton) of coal patch. 2nd Fabrizio.

Barrett asked about a statement to the residents regarding snow plowing and being responsible for clearing the roads not worrying about which way the snow plow is turned to avoid snow in their parking places or driveway entrances.

Hosler made a motion to adjourn the meeting. 2nd Fayash. All approved.
