The Regular meeting of the Supervisors of Schuylkill Township was held virtually on Zoom on Monday, May 4th, 2020. The Pledge of the Allegiance was recited. Those present included Charles Fayash, Charles Hosler, and Frank Fabrizio. Also present were Atty. Baranko and Colleen Barrett.

Charles Hosler made a motion to approve the April Meeting Minutes. 2nd Fayash. All approved.

Treasurer's Report

\$414,789.76 total in bank accounts. Charles Fayash made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report pending audit. 2nd Hosler. All approved.

Visa credit card report - \$49.84 payment for Ink Jets toner cartridges.

Public comment on agenda items only - none

Police Report – Fayash reported that DiMarco told him the tickets are in. Also Fayash reported that they had a drug bust at the Mary D Ballfield. Fayash also reported that we are approved for a grant from the John E Morgan Foundation for \$28,500 to fund equipment for police vehicles. A Resolution is needed. DiMarco needs to send paperwork to Baranko.

Code Enforcement Report – None

Roadmaster Report- – Hosler reported potholes were patched and he picked up a load of coal patch. Hosler did not get a quote yet for the roads.

Hosler stated the township taped off playground, patched potholes, cut back trees and branches, cleared drain grates, picked up trash and tires on Old 209, fixed wood at playground from police chase. Fayash stated water authority does not have any plans to do work on the possible areas of paving. Discussed road paving for spring.

Solicitors Report-Atty. Lucas discussed Resolution regarding adding a refundable fee to the Resolution for Subdivision & Land Development but the draft of the Resolution does not account for the increase in the subdivision fees so it was tabled until the next meeting. All approved tabling the issue. Hosler made a motion to extend the emergency declaration with Resolution 2020-3 until the next meeting June 1st. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved.

Zoning Report- Three zoning permits were issued in April (Frantz – shed, Habel – pole building, Dannenfelser – porch). One UCC building permit was issued in April (Dannenfelser).

Old Business - Fayash made a motion to table amusement tax assessment. 2nd Hosler. All approved.

Discussion about GPS in three vehicles –One Step GPS does not require a contract, \$47.90 per vehicle (which includes 2 months and activation fee). GPS is \$13.95 per vehicle a month with multiple people able to access it. GPS was tabled until next meeting. Hosler made a motion to go with One Step GPS to put GPS in three vehicles. 2nd Fabrizio. Fayash Nay.

New Business- Discussion of extending the discount rate for municipal property taxes or waive any fees or penalties associated with late payments. Fayash made a motion to extend the discount rate if the county extends the discount rate. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved. Hosler made a motion to extended the Matsago/Portz final amended plan submission for 90 days. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved. Discussion about the garbage fees. Fayash made a motion to keep the garbage fee at \$172.00. 2nd Hosler. All approved. Hosler made a motion to pay the Schuylkill Chamber of Commerce annual dues of \$325.00. 2nd Fayash. All approved. Fayash made a motion to pay the first payment of \$1,885.00 for General Code. 2nd Hosler. All approved.

Public Comment – None were submitted via email for this meeting.

Fayash made a motion to adjourn the meeting. 2nd Fabrizio. All approved.
