AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING, OPENING, AND LAYING OUT A ROAD IN SCHUYLKILL TOWN-SHIP TO BE KNOWN AS EMERICK STREET IN THE WILLAGE OF BROCKTON

Schuylkill Township hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

SECTION 1 - The following road or street in the Village of Brockton, hereby designated as Emerick Street, extending for from a point on the north side of Green Street thence northwardly for a distance of 580.70 feet to the north side of an alley, at a uniform width throughout of 55.40 feet is hereby adopted, laid out, and opened as a public road or street of Schuylkill Township.

SECTION 2 - The center line of said Emerick Street shall be a line located midway between the property lines as established by a survey of Martin J. Donohue, Registered Surveyor No. 13788-E in Drawing No. 72-F-015 and dated December 18, 1974, on a course north 9 degrees 40 minutes west, including within said street as part thereof those portions along the east side of Emerick Street released to Schuylkill Township by the several abutting property owners for the purpose of a public street.

SECTION 3 - All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
