TOWNSHIP OF SCHUYLKILL ORDINANCE 77- 4

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE OPERATION ON CERTAIN TOWNSHIP HIGHWAYS OR ROADS VEHICLES WITH WEIGHTS AND LOADS EXCEEDING CERTAIN GROSS WEIGHTS; AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Schuylkill Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, and it hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

WHEREAS, in order to protect certain highways or roads, hereinafter described, for the maintenance of which the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Schuylkill, County of Schuylkill, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, is responsible and to insure the safety of traffic thereon, it is necessary to prohibit the operation on such highways or roads of motor vehicles with aggregate weights and loads in excess of the gross weights hereinafter set forth.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred upon

Second Class Townships by Section 1101 of the Act of May 1, 1929,

P. L. 905, as amended, and Section 702, Subsection XLI of the Act
of July 10, 1947, P. L. 1481, as amended, the Board of Supervisors
of Schuylkill Township does hereby enact and ordain that:

Section 1.

After proper official signs have been placed, as hereinafter provided, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate upon the following designated township highways or roads any motor vehicle, truck, tractor, trailer or semi-trailer, or combination thereof, with an aggregate weight and load in excess of the gross weight hereinafter specified for each highway or road:

Old Route No. 209 throughout the Township of Schuylkill, eight (8) tons.

Section 2.

The proper township authorities are hereby directed
