TOWNSHIP OF SCHUYLKILL

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A VACATION
OF A PORTION OF COAL STREET BETWEEN
STRAWBERRY STREET AND CATAWISSA STREET
IN THE VILLAGE OF TUSCARORA, SCHUYLKILL
TOWNSHIP, SCHUYLKILL COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
ENACTED PURSUANT TO THE ACT OF MAY 1, 1933,
P.L. 103, ART. XI, § 1101 (53 P.S. § 66101),
AS AMENDED.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Schuylkill Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. The following portion of Coal Street, between Strawberry Street and Catawissa Street, Tuscarora, Schuylkill Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, is hereby vacated:

BEGINNING at a point in the Southwest corner of Strawberry and Coal Streets; thence along the South property line of Coal Street South Sixty-nine Degrees Twelve Minutes West (S. 69° 12' W.) Two Hundred (200') Feet to a point at the Southeast corner of Coal and Catawissa Streets; thence North Twenty Degrees Forty-eight Minutes West (N. 20° 48' W.) Fifty (50') Feet to a point at the Northeast corner of Coal and Catawissa Streets; thence along the North property line of Coal Street North Sixty-nine Degrees Twelve Minutes East (N. 69° 12' E.) Two Hundred (200') Feet to a point at the Northwest corner of Strawberry and Coal Streets; thence South Twenty Degrees Forty-eight Minutes East (S. 20° 48' E.) Fifty (50') Feet to a point, the place of beginning.

CONTAINING 0.23 Acre.

SECTION 2. The Township Secretary shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance, and cause the same to be filed with the Clerk of Courts, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30)

days after approval as so certified.


