ORDINANCE NO. 91-4

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE
NO. 84-3, ADOPTED SEPTEMBER 5,
1984, WHICH PROHIBITED CHILDREN
UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE TO BE
OR REMAIN IN OR UPON ANY OF THE
STREETS, ALLEYS, OR PUBLIC PLACES
IN SCHUYLKILL TOWNSHIP, SCHUYLKILL
COUNTY, AT NIGHT AFTER THE HOUR OF
TEN (10:00) O'CLOCK P.M. ON WEEKDAYS
AND ELEVEN (11:00) O'CLOCK P.M. ON
WEEKENDS UNLESS ACCOMPANIED AS HEREIN
PROVIDED; PRESCRIBING THE MANNER OF
ENFORCEMENT AND FIXING THE PENALTY
FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Schuylkill, Schuylkill County, as follows:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 84-3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3. Any child as above designated found upon the Township streets, alleys, or public places within the Township, in violation of Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be taken into custody by the police and delivered to his or her parents, guardian, or person having legal custody of said child. If said parent, guardian, or person having the legal custody of said child shall again allow him or her to be on said streets, alleys, or public places in violation of Section 1 of this Ordinance, said parent, guardian, or person having the legal custody of said child so offending shall be guilty of a summary offense punishable by a fine of not more than Twenty-Five

(\$25.00) Dollars nor less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars and costs, and, in default of payment of such fines and costs, to be imprisoned in the county jail for not more than five (5) days at the discretion of the magistrate, and a like fine or imprisonment shall be imposed upon any person aiding or abetting in the violation of the intent and purpose of this Ordinance.

Section 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
