ORDINANCE NO. 1998-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHUYLKILL TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 1-71, RELATING TO THE DEFERMENT OF TOWNSHIP OCCUPATIONAL TAXES;

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SCHUYLKILL, COUNTY OF SCHUYLKILL, PENNSYLVANIA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. ORDINANCE NO. 71-1 IS HEREBY AMENDED TO INCLUDE SECTION 16 – TAX DEFERMENTS TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 16 – TAX DEFERMENTS</u> Township Occupational Taxes will be deferred when any of the following conditions are met;

- (a) The income of the individual Taxpayer is \$5,000 or less.

 The income of the individual Taxpayer owning his home is \$6,000 or less.
- (b) The joint income for a family is \$8,000 or less.

 The joint income for a family owning their home is \$9,000 or less.
- (c) The taxpayer is an unmarried student who is dependent on his or her parents for support.
- (d) The taxpayer is a member of the Armed Services in a non-career category.
- (e) The taxpayer is 75 years of age or older.
- (f) The taxpayer is 65 years of age, but less than 75 years of age, is retired, and has an individual income of \$4,000 or less.
- (g) Special family conditions exist which require individual consideration by the Board of Supervisors, or on request in writing to the Board.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> ORDINANCE NO. 71-1 IS HEREBY AMENDED TO INCLUDE SECTION 17 – DEADLINE FOR FILING TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 17 – DEADLINE FOR FILING</u> – Each individual shall file for occupational tax deferment by March 31 of the fiscal year for which deferment is requested. Requests for deferment after the deadline date will be rejected by the Board of Supervisors.
