ORDINANCE NO. 1999-# TOWNSHIP OF SCHUYLKILL

AN ORDINANCE VACATING OR ABANDONING A PORTION OF A PUBLIC STREET, KNOWN AS UNION STREET, BELOW OLD ROUTE 209 IN BROCKTON AND BETWEEN VALLEY STREET AND T-549, IN THE TOWNSHIP OF SCHUYLKILL, SCHUYLKILL COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Township of Schuylkill, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The following portion of Union Street, as designated, is hereby vacated and abandoned as a public street in the Township of Schuylkill:

A. West Portion of Union Street.

Beginning at an Iron pin set at the intersection Western Right-of-Way line of Union Street and the Southern Right-of-Way line of Valley Street, said corner also being the North East corner of the land of the now or late James J. Milot;

Thence along the Westerly Right-of-Way of Union Street and along the lands of James J. Milot the following course and distance:

South 12 degrees 05 minutes 01 seconds East, a distance of 205.92 feet to an iron pin set at the Northern Right-of-Way line of Township road T-549;

Thence along said Township road T-549 the following course and distance:

North 5 degrees 16 minutes 26 seconds East, a distance of 50.10 feet to an iron pin set at the intersection of said Township road T-549 and the center line of Unon Street;

Thence along the centerline of Union Street the following course and distance:

North 12 degrees 05 minutes 01 seconds West, a distance of 154.44 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence along the southern Right-of-Way line of Valley Street the following course and distance:

North 88 degrees 18 minutes 56 seconds West, a distance of 15.39 feet to an iron pin set, the place of beginning.

Containing 2702.65 square feet or 0.0620 acres.

B. East Portion of Union Street

Beginning at an iron pin set at the intersection Eastern Right-of-Way line of Union Street and the Southern Right-of-Way line of Valley Street, said corner also being the North West corner of the land of the now or late Joseph Pedron:

Thence along the Easterly Right-of-Way of Union Street and along the lands of Joseph Pedron the following course and distance:

South 12 degrees 05 minutes 01 seconds East, a distance of 154.44 feet to an iron pin set at the Northern Right-of-Way line of Township road T-549;

Thence along said Township road T-549 the following course and distance:

North 88 degrees 18 minutes 56 seconds West, a distance of 15.44 feet to an iron pin set at the intersection of said Township road T-549 and the centerline of Union Street;

Thence along the centerline of Union Street the following course and distance:

North 12 degrees 05 minutes 01 seconds West, a distance of 154.44 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence along the Southern Right-of-Way line of Valley street the following course and distance:

South 88 degrees 18 minutes 56 seconds East, a distance of 15.50 feet to an iron pin set, the place of beginning.

Containing 2316.56 square feet or 0.0532 acres.

SECTION 2. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. The following ordinances or parts thereof are specifically repealed:

SECTION 3. Severability. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Township of Schuylkill that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon its final adoption by the Supervisors of the Township of Schuylkill.
