RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SCHUYLKILL TOWNSHIP, SCHUYLKILL COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA (herein after "the municipality").

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act", as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires the Municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said Plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the Municipality, and

WHEREAS, **alfred benesch & company** has prepared a Joint Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Update on behalf of the Schuylkill Valley Sewer Authority, of which Schuylkill Township is a member, which provides for sewage facilities in a portion of the Schuylkill Township, and

The alternative of choice to be implemented is the one-plant alternative which provides for sewage collection systems in the Boroughs of New Philadelphia and Middleport and the Townships of Blythe and Schuylkill that discharge to a new treatment facility to be located in Blythe Township.

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the monthly user charge for the chosen alternative will be approximately Forty (\$40.00) Dollars per month per EDU.

WHEREAS, Schuylkill Township finds that the Facility Plan described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Schuylkill Township, hereby adopts and submits to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the "Official Plan" of the Municipality, the above referenced Facility Plan. The Municipality hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said Plan as required by law. (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act as amended).

AND ALSO, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Schuylkill Township hereby authorizes Schuylkill Valley Sewer Authority to apply for and receive any grants from all state and federal agencies which may be available for any planning and design assistance related to the above referenced revision.
